<p><u>The 'Muslim' group</u></p> <p>What do you think is the most important way that Muslims show that they belong to Islam?</p>	<p>They go to the mosque 5 times a day to pray ✓.</p>
<p><u>Communion</u></p> <p>Many Christians go to church to take Communion (bread and wine).</p> <p>Why is this important to them?</p>	<p>because at the last supper JESUS got bread and wine to share.</p>
<p><u>Showing someone is a Christian</u></p> <p>Do you think that taking bread and wine is the only way that someone can show that they are a Christian?</p>	<p>NO because you can get baptisms as well.</p>
