<p><u>Belonging to a group</u></p> <p>What might show that a person belongs to a group or club?</p>	<p>List 4 things</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • They might have uniforms • An interest • A set of rules • Logo ✓
<p><u>Baptism</u></p> <p>How does baptism help someone to belong to the 'Christian' group?</p>	<p>It shows that you will be Christian and make your first promise to the group. ✓✓</p>
<p><u>The 'Muslim' group</u></p> <p>What do you think is the most important way that Muslims show that they belong to Islam?</p>	<p>Doing the five daily prayers and facing towards Mekkah also following the five pillars of Islam. ✓</p>
<p><u>Communion</u></p> <p>Many Christians go to church to take Communion (bread and wine).</p> <p>Why is this important to them?</p>	<p>To remember that they are forgiven and that if they have been disrespectful they can forget about it. ✓</p> <p>How do they know this? What story links to their belief?</p>
<p><u>Showing someone is a Christian</u></p> <p>Do you think that taking bread and wine is the only way that someone can show that they are a Christian?</p>	<p>No. They can be baptised and maybe have a necklace or bracelet of the cross so they can be confident in Jesus. ✓</p>
